Dear Applicant(s) / Property owner(s):

On April 1, 2019, the Board of Zoning Adjustment considered your request for a **Parking Surface Variance to allow an aggregate parking surface in a B-2, Neighborhood Business District** at the above referenced location.

After discussion, the Board determined the following findings of fact for Approval:

- 1) The variance will not be contrary to the public interest;**
- 2) Special conditions exist such that a literal enforcement of the provisions of the chapter will result in unnecessary hardship; and**
- 3) The spirit of the chapter shall be observed and substantial justice done to the applicant and the surrounding neighborhood by granting the variance.**

Any party aggrieved by this decision may, within fifteen days of the date of the decision, appeal to the Circuit Court of Mobile County by filing a written notice of appeal, specifying the decision from which the appeal is taken. Notice of the appeal, as well as a date stamped copy of the appeal filed in Circuit Court must be filed with this Board within the fifteen-day appeal period.

No permit, license or certification can be issued until the 15-day appeal period has expired and no appeal has been made. If a permit/license has not been obtained on or before October 1, 2019, the **Parking Surface Variance** will expire and become null and void. For additional assistance call (251) 208-5895.


